

## HLTAID014 PROVIDE ADVANCED FIRST AID (LEVEL 3 FIRST AID)

### Description

This intensive advanced first aid course provides the skills and knowledge to provide a higher level of first aid response, life support, management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of emergency services arrives.

The course applies to all person who may be required to provide an advanced first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

### Course cost / duration

Cost: \$465.00 per person  
Course duration: 3 days - 8:30am – 4:00pm each day

### Group bookings:

Melbourne metropolitan area - minimum course cost based on 8 people  
Victorian country locations - minimum course cost based on 12 people

### Course content

- Casualty assessment, observations and history taking
- Coordinating first aid activities including triage, dealing with multiple casualties, casualty packaging and movement
- Medical emergencies such as: cardiac emergencies, anaphylaxis, asthma, choking, burns, envenomation, head & spinal injuries, bleeding control, fractures, dislocations, soft tissue injuries, hazardous substances and emergency childbirth
- Life threatening bleeding requiring the use of tourniquets and haemostatic dressings
- Assess vital signs of casualty while completing first aid scenarios, plus much more...



### Assessment

A Statement of Attainment will be issued on successful completion of a range of assessments. This may include pre-course online learning tasks, verbal interviews and the observation of practical skills such as following the prompts of an AED, completing CPR on a manikin on the floor, using first aid equipment/resources when providing first aid for asthma, anaphylaxis and envenomation
